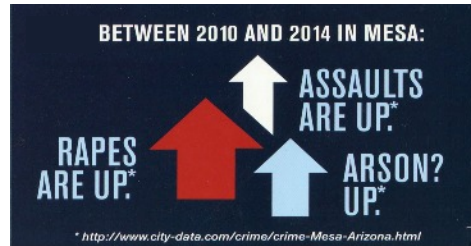


City Council's JOB is to figure out how to meet the NEEDS of the Mesa community.
